By referring to page No.31 of the typed set of papers, he points out that the survey was conducted on 19.05.2025 in respect of the above mentioned land. He further submits that the petitioner has an appellate remedy, if dissatisfied with such survey.

3.The Tamil Nadu Survey and Boundaries Act, 1923 provides for an appellate remedy before the Assistant Director of Survey. Therefore, I am not inclined to entertain this writ petition.

4.Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of by leaving it open to the petitioner to file an appeal in accordance with the statute. No costs.
