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ORDER

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This Criminal Original Petition is filed seeking to quash the first Information Report in Crime No.82 of 2022, dated 07.03.2022 on the file of the first respondent Police, which was registered for the offences under Sections 147, 148, 294(b), 323, 324 and 506(ii) of IPC.

2.The gist of the allegation in the FIR is that on account of prior enmity, the petitioners attacked the defacto complainant with knife and sticks, besides committing the offence of criminal intimidation and thus, committed the aforesaid offences.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned counsel for the defacto complainant/the second respondent would submit that the parties have now entered into a compromise on the advise of the elders and well-wishers and both the parties have agreed that the impugned F.I.R may be quashed.

4.The parties have also filed a joint compromise memo dated 10.09.2025. The scanned copy of the compromise memo reads as follows:

**JOINT COMPROMISE MEMO FILED BY THE PETITIONER

1. It is submitted that the 2nd respondent given an information before the 1st respondent and alleged that the petitioners attacked the defacto complainant and scolded him with filthy language and threatened him with dire consequences and thereby committed the offences. Further, no fruitful result will be yield if the investigation would be continued in Crime No. 82/2022 on the file of the 1st respondent, when the parties pertain to the above case have amicably settled the matter and arrived at a compromise.

6.Considering the nature of the offences and the fact that the parties have arrived at a compromise, this Court is of the view that no useful purpose would be served by keeping the impugned FIR pending investigation. Accordingly, the impugned FIR in Crime No.82 of 2022, on the file of the first respondent police, is quashed. The petitioners shall pay a sum of Rs.10,000/- as costs to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre attached to the Madurai Bench of Madras High Court forthwith and file a photocopy of the receipt along with a memo reporting compliance in the Registry.

7. Hence, this Criminal Original Petition stand allowed.
