PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.483 of BNSS

PRAYER :- For Bail in Crime No.279 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER :- The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on



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04.07.2025 for the offences punishable under Sections 191(2), 191(3), 296(b), 103(1), 351(3) and 49 of BNS, 2023, in Crime No.279 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that due to previous enmity, on 03.07.2025 at about 6.15 p.m., while the defacto complainant along with deceased Balakrishnan were standing near the Muthalamman Temple, the petitioner along with other accused person abused the deceased Balakrishnan in filthy language and attacked him with a knife , as a result of which he died on the spot. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offences as alleged by the prosecution. He further submitted that the petitioner is in judicial custody from 04.07.2025. Hence, he seeks bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that the petitioner along with other accused person attacked the deceased with a knife, as a result of which he died on the spot. He further submitted that the investigation is almost completed.

5. Taking into consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the period of incarceration suffered by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to the following conditions:



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6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate Court III, Dindigul District, and on further conditions that :-

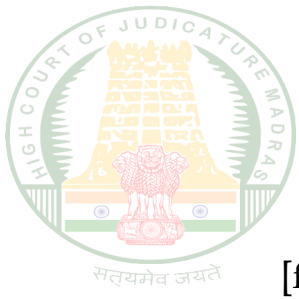
[a] the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhaar card or bank pass book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., until further orders. He has to co-operate for the investigation.

[c] the petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner is released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].



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[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered
under Section 269 BNS.
