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ORDER

The petitioners seek to quash the final report in C.C.No.356 of 2023, pending on the file of the Judicial Magistrate No.II, Virudhunagar, which was filed for the offences under Sections 34, 294(b), 406, 420 and 506(i) of IPC.

2. The allegation in the final report is that there is a money dispute between the petitioner and the defacto complainant; that the petitioner had purchased googs from the defacto complainant to the tune of Rs.1,01,80,680/-; and that when the said amount was demanded by the defacto complainant, the petitioners abused the defacto complainant in filthy language, attacked him and threatened him of dire consequences and thus, committed the aforesaid offences.

3. Admittedly, the petitioners and the second respondent have now entered into a compromise and decided to give a quietus to the entire dispute. The parties have filed a joint compromise memo dated 23rd September 2025 and the scanned copy of the compromise memo reads as follows:
