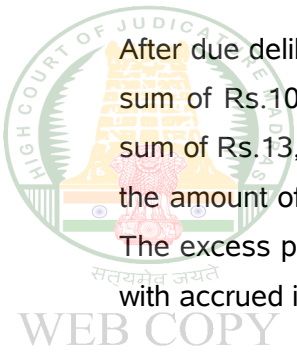

This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. The counsel for the appellant Mr. V. Sakthivel and the counsel for the respondents Mr. Theethar are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.

AWARD

Aggrieved by the award passed by the Tribunal, the Appellant/Insurance Company has filed the present appeal.



After due deliberations, both the parties have agreed into compromise and agreed to modify the sum of Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs Only) towards full quit. The appellant has already paid a sum of Rs.13,76,587/- (Rupees Thousand Only) before the Tribunal. The claimants are entitled to withdraw the amount of Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs Only), by filing formal application before the Court below. The excess payment made by the Insurance Company, shall be refunded to the Insurance company along with accrued interest.

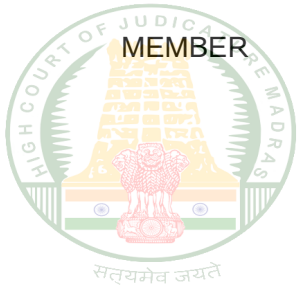
This Lok Adalat award is passed in terms of the above settlement.
