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ORDER

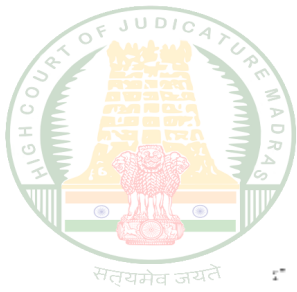
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This Criminal Original Petition is filed seeking to quash the FIR in Crime No.270 of 2016 on the file of the first respondent Police, which was registered for the offences under Sections 294(b) and 506(2) of IPC.

2. The allegation against the petitioner is on account of prior enmity, the petitioner abused the defacto complainant in filthy language and also criminally intimidated him and thus, committed the aforesaid offences.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned counsel for the defacto complainant/the second respondent would submit that the parties have now entered into a compromise on the advise of the elders and well-wishers and both the parties have agreed that the impugned F.I.R may be quashed.

4.The parties have also filed a joint compromise memo. The scanned copy of the compromise memo reads as follows:

JOINT COMPROMISE MEMO

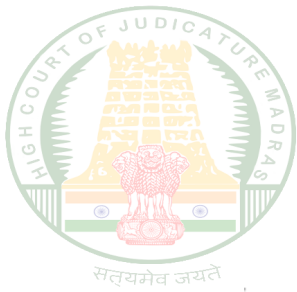
It is submitted that both the parties hereby enter into a compromise and agree on the following terms.

1. It is respectfully submitted that the Petitioner preferred this instant Criminal Original Petition praying this Hon'ble Court to call for the records pertaining to the First Information Report in Crime No.270 of 2016 dated 17.05.2016 on the file of the Respondent no.1 Police and quash the same as illegal.

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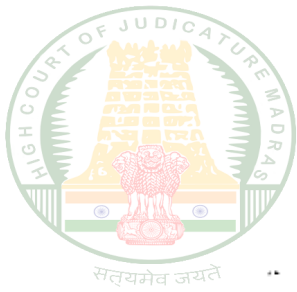
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2. It is respectfully submitted that the prosecution case is that the petitioner has come to the working place of the petitioner and criminally intimidated the defacto complainant and verbally abused him. Hence the impugned FIR was registered against the petitioner for offences under Section 294(b), 506(2) of IPC in Crime No.270 of 2016 on the file of the 2nd respondent.
3. That there was already a civil dispute filed by the Petitioner's Mother against the Defacto Complainant before the District Munsif Court, Thirumangalam in O.S.No.52/2019. Hence this petitioner had disturbed the defacto complainant while the ritual performed for Boomi Pooja in his housing plot on 23.04.2025 and with the past enmity petitioner herein had criminally intimidated the defacto complainant in his working place to stop the construction work in the plot which is situated near the petitioner's mother residence. Hence the defacto complainant had lodged another complaint. FIR was registered against the petitioner in Crime No.144 dated 25.05.2025 for offences under sections 296(b), 232(1), 351(1) of BNS.
4. That the petitioners and the Respondent no.2 are neighbors and they are amicably settled these issues and they don't want to proceed this criminal proceedings against the petitioner.
5. That the Respondent no. 2 is not having any objection for quashing the FIR and does not want to prosecute the case forthwith, as the matter is settled amicably.
6. It is submitted now both the parties decided to withdraw all the allegations made against each other and have settled the dispute amicably in the presence of elderly persons. Hence the FIR may be quashed on the ground that the matter has been settled.

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Therefore it is most respectfully prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to record this Joint Compromise Memo as part and parcel of the quash petition and quash the Impugned First Information Report in Crime No.270 of 2016 dated 17.05.2016 on the file of the Respondent No.1 and thus render justice.

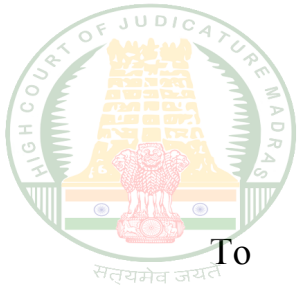

They are identified by Mr.Paramasivam, Sub Inspector of Police, Nagamalai Puthukottai Police Station, Madurai District. All the parties confirmed the compromise arrived at between them.

6.Considering the nature of the offences and the fact that the parties have arrived at a compromise, this Court is of the view that no useful purpose would be served by keeping the impugned FIR pending investigation. Accordingly, the impugned FIR in Crime No.270 of 2016, on the file of the first respondent police, is quashed and the Criminal Original Petition stands allowed.
