Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing respondents No.1 and 2 to carry out the Survey and Demarcation of the boundaries work in the petitioners landed property comprised in Survey Nos.301/14A, 301/17 and 301/19 situated at Madur Village, Dindigul East Taluk, Dindigul with the aid of the 3rd respondent Police on the basis of her Application dated 23.01.2024 after affording an opportunity to the parties concerned within the time as stipulated by this Honble Court and for other reliefs.
