Heard Mr.A.Senthilkumar, learned counsel for the Petitioner, Mr.D.Selvanayagam, learned counsel for R1 to R6 and Mr.Vaikkam Karunanithi, learned Government Advocate for R7.

The learned Counsel for the Petitioner submits that this Criminal Miscellaneous Petition has been filed under Section 5 of the Limitation Act, 1963, seeking to condone the delay of 28 days in filing the criminal revision petition against the order dated 09.12.2024 passed in C.A.No.28 of 2021 on the file of the learned Additional District and Sessions Judge (FTC), Kumbakonam and confirming the order dated 05.12.2019 passed in C.C.No.140 of 2012 on the file of the District Munsif Cum Judicial Magistrate Papanasam.
