4.Given the nature of relief claimed, it is unnecessary to issue notice to the private respondents in this writ petition. Instead, this writ petition is disposed of by directing the first respondent to consider and dispose of the



petitioner's appeal within 12 weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order on merits after providing a reasonable opportunity to the petitioner and the private respondents herein. No costs.
