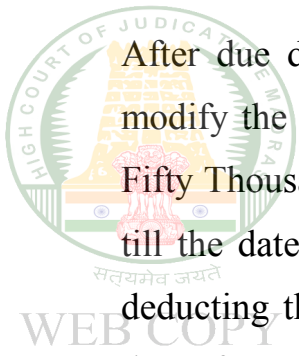

This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. The counsel for the appellant, Mr.B.Rajesh Saravanan and the counsel for the first respondent Mr.K.Sri Sabarisan are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.

AWARD

Aggrieved by the award passed by the Tribunal, the appellant / United India Insurance Company has filed the present appeal.



After due deliberations, both the parties have entered into compromise and modify the award amount to a sum of Rs.23,50,000/- (Rupees Twenty Three Fifty Thousand only) with interest at the rate of 7.5% per annum from the date of petition till the date of realization. The appellant is directed to deposit the award amount, after deducting the amount already deposited, if any, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this award. On such deposit being made, the first respondent is permitted to withdraw a sum of Rs. Rs.23,50,000/- (Rupees Twenty Three Lakhs and Fifty Thousand only) with interest at the rate of 7.5% per annum by filing formal application before the Tribunal.

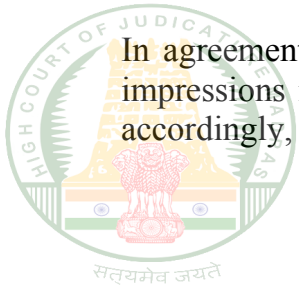
