Prayer : This Transfer Civil Miscellaneous Petition filed under Section 24 C.P.C., to withdraw the case in H.M.O.P.No.142 of 2024 on the file of the Family Court, Pudukkottai and to transfer the said case to the Family Court, Trichy.

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ORDER

The Transfer Civil Miscellaneous Petition is filed to withdraw the case from the file of the Family Court, Pudukkottai, in H.M.O.P.No.142 of 2024 and transfer the same to the file of the Family Court, Trichy.

2. Heard the learned counsel on either side.

3. It is evident from the records that the marriage between the petitioner and the respondent was solemnized on 01.02.2017 and due to their wedlock, they were blessed with two male children. It is not in dispute that the respondent has earlier filed a petition seeking restitution of conjugal rights, that the petitioner has filed an application for interim maintenance, which came to be awarded and that subsequently, the respondent has not pressed the petition and filed the present petition in H.M.O.P.No.142 of 2024 seeking divorce and the same is pending on the file of the Family Court, Pudukkottai. It is also not in dispute that the petitioner has laid a maintenance claim in M.C.No.112 of 2023 and the same is pending on the file of the Family Court, Trichy.



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4. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is residing at Palakarai, Trichy District and finds it difficult to travel to Pudukkottai to attend the hearings.

5. The learned counsel appearing for the respondent would submit that the respondent has been receiving threats and hence, he lodged a complaint. But the fact remains that maintenance case in M.C.No.112 of 2023 has already been pending before the Family Court, Trichy.

6. In the case of *N.C.V.Aishwarya Vs. A.S.Saravana Karthik Sha* reported in **2022 Live Law (SC) 627**, the Hon'ble Supreme Court has reiterated the position with generally, it is the wife's convenience, which must be looked at while considering the transfer petition under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure and the relevant passage is extracted hereunder :

“The cardinal principle for exercise of power under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure is that the ends of justice should demand the transfer of the suit, appeal or other proceeding. In matrimonial matters, wherever Courts are called upon to consider the plea of transfer, the Courts have to take into consideration the economic soundness of



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both the parties, the social strata of the spouses and their behavioural pattern, their standard of life prior to the marriage and subsequent thereto and the circumstances of both the parties in eking out their livelihood and under whose protective umbrella they are seeking their sustenance to life. Given the prevailing socioeconomic paradigm in the Indian society, generally, it is the wife's convenience which must be looked at while considering transfer.", the bench observed."

7. Considering the above facts and circumstances and also taking note of the fact that the petitioner is residing at Trichy District and her maintenance case is pending before the Family Court, Trichy, this Court is of the view that the case in H.M.O.P.No.142 of 2024 is ordered to be withdrawn from the file of the Family Court, Pudukkottai, and transfer the same to the file of the Family Court, Trichy. Accordingly, the learned Judge of Family Court, Pudukkottai, is hereby directed to transmit the entire records in H.M.O.P.No.142 of 2024 to the file of the Family Court, Trichy, within a period of 10 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and on receiving the case bundle, the learned Judge of Family Court, Trichy, is directed to take up the petition on file and proceed in accordance with law.



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8. With the above direction, the Transfer Civil Miscellaneous Petition stands allowed. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed. No costs.
