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ORDER

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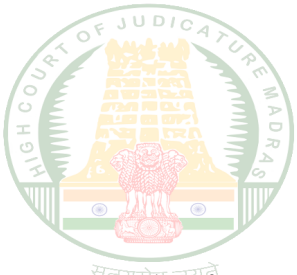
The Civil Miscellaneous Petition is filed to condone the delay of 185 days in filing this Second Appeal in S.A(MD)SR.No.64088 of 2024.

5. The delay that occurred is explained in paragraph No.11 of the affidavit. 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stand automatically dismissed without any further reference to the Court.
