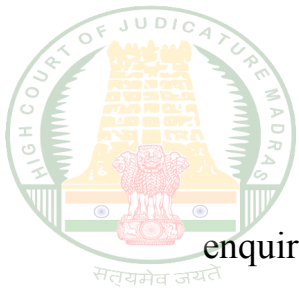

ORDER

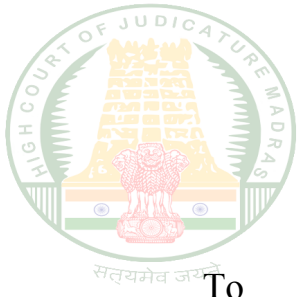
4. Considering the prayer sought for in this petition, this Court, without issuing notice to the other respondents, is inclined to pass orders.
