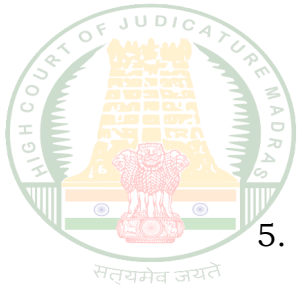
ORDER
