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respondents Nos. 2 to 4 herein to cancel the patta Nos.11094, 11090 and 11091 in favour of the fifth to seventh respondents and to rectify the wrong entry in the FMB sketch pertaining S.No.271/3C at Levanjipuram Village and Panchayat, Panagudi subdi, Radhapuram Taluk, Tirunelveli District with respect to 94 cents as per the joint patta No.994 by considering the petitioner's representation dated 27.01.2025.

ORDER

By this Writ Petition, the petitioner seeks consideration and disposal of the appeal before the Revenue Divisional Officer for cancellation of patta Nos.11094, 11090 and 11091.
