ORDER

The petitioner seeks to quash the impugned charge sheet in S.C.No.504 of 2023 on the file of the learned Assistant Sessions Court, Valliyoor, which



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was filed for the offences under Section 294(b), 307 and 506(2) IPC.

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2. The allegation in the final report is that the petitioner is the husband of the second respondent; that on 30.11.2020, due to matrimonial dispute, the petitioner abused the second respondent in filthy language and attacked her with knife and threatened her with dire consequences and thus, committed the aforesaid offences.

3. Though there is an allegation of offence under Section 307 IPC, it is seen that the injury suffered by the victims is simple in nature. Thus, the learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the offence under Section 307 of IPC has not been made out.

4. Admittedly, the petitioner and the second respondent are husband and wife and are now living together pursuant to a compromise and decided to give a quietus to the entire dispute. The parties have filed a joint compromise memo dated 26th September 2025 and the scanned copy of the compromise memo reads as follows:

Hence, the defacto complainant lodged this present complaint before the 1st respondent police and FIR came to be registered in crime No.253/2020 dated 30.11.2020 for the offences under section 294(b), 307, 506(ii) of IPC, section 4 of TNPHW Act 2002

The petitioners respectfully states that the said occurrence was happened due to some dispute between the petitioner and the 2nd respondent. 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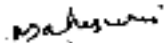
