PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.483 of BNSS

PRAYER:- For Bail in Crime No.326 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police.



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ORDER: The Court made the following order :-

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The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 01.09.2025 for the offences punishable under Section 329(4), 77 and 351(2) of BNS, 2023, in Crime No.326 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner and the defacto complainant's husband were friends. On 31.08.2025, after completing plumbing work near the defacto complainant's house, the petitioner secretly recorded a video on the defacto complainant, while she was sleeping and threatened her by showing video. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offences as alleged by the prosecution. He further submitted that the petitioner and the defacto complainant are friends and they were in illegal relationship for sometime, due to which, a false case has been foisted against the petitioner. The petitioner is in judicial custody from 01.09.2025. Hence, he seeks bail to the petitioner.



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4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that the petitioner and the defacto complainant's husband were friends and on 31.08.2025, after completing plumbing work near the defacto complainant's house, the petitioner secretly recorded a video on the defacto complainant, while she was sleeping and threatened her by showing video. He further submitted that mobile phone has been recorded. Hence, he opposed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

5.Taking into consideration of the facts and also considering the period of incarceration suffered by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to the following conditions:

6.Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Additional District Cum Judicial Magistrate, Veda sandur, and on further conditions that :-

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.



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[b] the petitioner shall furnish his residential address and mobile number to the learned Additional District Cum Judicial Magistrate, Vendasandur.

[c] If the petitioner changes his residential address, he shall report the same to the learned Additional District Cum Judicial Magistrate, Vendasandur.

[d] the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police twice in a week ie., on Every Monday and Friday **at 10.30 a.m.. until further orders**. He has to co-operate for the investigation.

[e] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[f] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[g] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid



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down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[h] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 BNS.
