This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. The counsel for the appellant/s Mr.R.Murugappan and the counsel for the respondent/s Mr.S.K.Yaswant Kumar are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.

AWARD

The husband, aggrieved by the order of the Family Court, Sivagangai District, in M.C.No. 49 of 2023 dated 27.10.2023 has preferred this Criminal Revision.



2. Today (i.e., 08.03.2025), the petitioner /husband as well as the respondent /wife are present along with their minor son. Both parties have resolved their disputes and they report that they have re-joined and are living together happily.

3. In view of the above change in circumstances, the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present Criminal Revision Case.

4. We have affirmed the said position with the respondent / wife and she confirms the same. In view of the above, the order made in M.C.No.49 of 2023 on the file of the Family Court, Sivagangai, is hereby set aside by the consent of both the parties. This Criminal Revision Case is disposed of, with the above terms.
