ORDER

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This Criminal Original Petition is filed seeking to quash the FIR in Crime No.275 of 2021 on the file of the first respondent Police, which was registered for the offences under Sections 294(b), 323 and 506(ii) of IPC.

2. The allegation in the FIR is that on account of prior enmity, the petitioner abused the defacto complainant in filthy language, attacked her and threatened with dire consequences and thus, committed the aforesaid offences.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned counsel for the defacto complainant/the second respondent would submit that the petitioner and the defacto complainant had a love affair; that there was a quarrel between them; that a complaint was lodged and that the parties have now entered into a compromise on the advise of the elders and well-wishers and both the parties have agreed that the impugned F.I.R may be quashed.

4. The parties have also filed a joint compromise memo dated 22.09.2025. The scanned copy of the compromise memo reads as follows:

The Petitioner above named begs to prefer this Memorandum of Criminal Original Petition praying to quash the FIR in Crime No.275 of 2021, dated 15.04.2021 by the 1st respondent police for the alleged offences under Sections 294[b], 323, 506 [ii] of IPC and Section 4 of Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Harassment of Women Act 2002.
2. The petitioner submits that the case of the prosecution is that the petitioner and the 2nd respondent/defacto complaint were loved each other, but the petitioner's family members arranged a marriage for the petitioner with some other girl. Due to which the 2nd respondent/defacto complaint break up the relationship with the petitioner. Due to such motive on the date of occurrence that the petitioner assaulted the 2nd respondent/defacto complaint and abused her by using filthy language further threatened with dire consequences. Hence, the present complaint.
3. The petitioner submits that he never committed any offence as alleged by the 1st Respondent police and hence the said complaint is liable to be quashed.
