5. Hence, forth they are ready to withdraw all the litigations

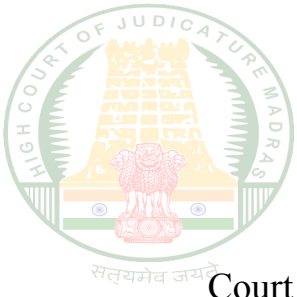
