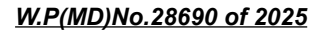

3. It is well settled that in the matter of condonation of delay, the authority should be fairly liberal. The delay in this case is not inordinate. I went through the reasons assigned by the writ petitioner for the delay. I am satisfied that sufficient cause has been made out. Notwithstanding the strong opposition by the learned standing counsel, I am of the view that appeal filed by the assessee deserves to be dealt with on merits.
