PRAYER : Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of Writ of Mandamus, directing the 3rd Respondent to survey the land in Survey No.285/8B, Poolangal Village, Aruppukottai Taluk, Virudhunagar District and fix the boundaries and consequentially



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directing the 4th Respondent to provide adequate Police Protection during the course of survey in view of the representation dated 20.05.2025 within the stipulated time.

ORDER

The petitioner applied online for the survey of land in Survey No.285/8B, Poolangal Village. The present writ petition relates thereto.

2. Learned Government Advocate points out that the patta in respect of the above-mentioned survey number stands in the name of the husband of the fifth respondent. He also points out that the petitioner has initiated proceedings before the Revenue Divisional Officer for cancellation thereof. In these circumstances, he submits that survey cannot be undertaken on application by the petitioner.



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3. As submitted by learned Government Advocate, the patta stands in the name of Sheikh Mohammed, who is the husband of the fifth respondent. The statement that proceedings are pending for cancellation of such patta is admitted by all the parties. Therefore, until conclusion of such proceedings, petitioner's request for survey cannot be acted upon. By leaving it open to the petitioner to re-apply for a survey if he were to succeed in proceedings before the Revenue Divisional Officer, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
