ORDER

2. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the second respondent brought to the notice of this Court that the petitioner has been implicated in a criminal case in Crime No.364 of 2023 on the file of the second respondent police, which has culminated in filing of a charge sheet in C.C.No.1323 of 2025 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.1, Ramanathapuram.

3. In view of the above said submissions, the petitioner is directed to approach the trial Court concerned seeking permission of the Court to go abroad. In case, if any such application is filed, the same shall be disposed of within a period of four weeks. Based upon the order passed by the Judicial
