PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.483 of BNSS

PRAYER :- For Bail in C.C.No.36 of 2019 arising out of Crime No.160 of 2016, on the file of the Judicial Magistrate, Uthamapalayam.

ORDER : This Court made the following order :-

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The petitioner / Accused, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 01.09.2025 for the offences punishable under Sections 379 and 482 of IPC, in C.C.No.36 of 2019 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Uthamapalayam, in Crime No.160 of 2016 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that after the registration of the case in Crime No.160 of 2016 and the respondent police have completed the investigation and filed a charge sheet in C.C.No.36 of 2019, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Uthamapalayam. He further submitted that due to non-appearance of the petitioner, the trial Court has issued NBW against the petitioner and the same was executed on 01.09.2025. He further submitted that the petitioner undertakes that he will not abscond and he will regularly appear before the Trial Court on hearing dates without fail. He further submitted that the petitioner is in judicial custody from 01.09.2025. Hence, he seeks bail.

3. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that the petitioner failed to appear before the trial Court, due to which the trial Court had issued Non Bailable Warrant to the petitioner. Hence, he vehemently opposed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

4. Taking into consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the undertaking given by the learned Counsel for the petitioner and also considering the period of incarceration suffered by the petitioner, this court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to the following conditions:

5. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Uthamapalayam, and on further conditions that :-

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.
