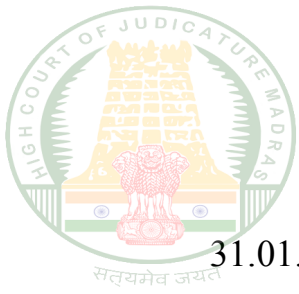
ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners, who were arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 31.01.2025 for the offences punishable under Sections 191(2), 191(3), 296(b), 103(2) and 61(2) of BNS, in Crime No.65 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police in connection with the S.C.No. 189 of 2025 pending on the file of the learned Principal District and Sessions Court, Thiruchirappalli, seek bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioners along with other accused persons had followed the two-wheeler of the defacto complainant and chased him and pushed him down, and attacked him with Aruval, due to which he got grievous injuries and thereafter he died. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent persons and they have not committed any offences as alleged by the prosecution. He further submitted that the petitioners are ready and willing to abide by any conditions which may be imposed by this Court and they are in judicial custody from

31.01.2025. Hence, he seeks bail to the petitioners.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that there are 3 previous cases pending as against the 1st petitioner and two previous cases pending against the 2nd petitioner. He further submitted that the petitioners were detained under Goondas Act and the same was revoked. Hence, he opposed for grant of bail to the petitioners.

5. Taking into consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and also consideration the period of incarceration suffered by the petitioners, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners, subject to the following conditions:

6. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on executing a separate bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate Court, Srirangam, Thiruchirappalli District, and on further conditions that :-

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioners shall appear before the concerned court daily at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.

[c] the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioners shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].
