ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners, who were arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 08.10.2025 for the offences punishable under Sections 296(b), 115(2), 132, 121(1), 351(2) of BNS and 4 of TNPPDL Act, in Crime No.337 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police, seek bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that on 07.10.2025, at about 8:15 p.m., while the defacto complainant and his colleague were on patrol near Bodi Vilaku, the petitioners were found preparing to consume alcohol in a car bearing Registration No.KL-07-BJ-4111. When the same was questioned, they quarrelled with the police, obstructed them from performing their duty, assaulted two bystanders, and damaged the rear windshield of the patrol vehicle. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent person and they have not committed any offences as alleged by the prosecution. He further submitted that the petitioners are in judicial custody from 08.10.2025. Hence, he seeks bail to the

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that no previous case is pending against the petitioners.

5. Taking into consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the period of incarceration suffered by the petitioners, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners, subject to the following conditions:

6. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Theni, and on further conditions that :-

[a] the petitioners and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhaar card or bank pass book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioner shall report before the Dean of Theni Government Hospital daily at 10.30 a.m., and shall do social service at the said hospital till 4.00 p.m., for a period of two weeks. Thereafter, the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily evening at 6.00 p.m., until further orders.

[c] the petitioners shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

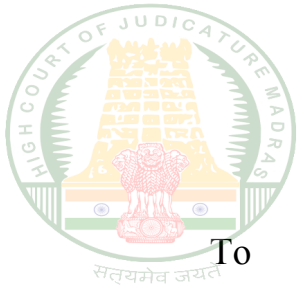
[d] the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner is released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 BNS.
