For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.26 of 2025 on the file of the
respondent police

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

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The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 5(1), 5(j)(ii) and 6(1) of POCSO Act, in Crime No.26 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that due to love affair, the petitioner herein married the victim girl, who is a minor. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) submits that it is a case of child marriage and the investigation of the case is pending.

4. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondent police.

5. Considering the nature of allegation against the petitioner and that it is a case of love affair, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, subject to certain conditions.



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5. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Mahila Court, Pudukkottai, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and on further conditions that:

[a] the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhaar card or bank pass book to ensure their identity;

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent Police as and when required for interrogation before the respondent police;

[c] the petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.
