PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.482 of BNSS

PRAYER :- C-38AB For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.
542 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/A2, who apprehends arrest at the
hands of the respondent police for the offences
punishable under Sections 126(2), 308(4) and 351(3)



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of BNS, in Crime No.542 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that when the defacto complainant was proceeding near Kuppanna Hotel in his Swift Dezire car, the accused obstructed the defacto complainant and threatened him at knife point and taken away a sum of Rs.18,000/- from his pocket. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and has not committed any offences as alleged by the prosecution, and he has been falsely implicated in this case. He further submitted that the petitioner is ready and willing to abide by any conditions which may be imposed by this Court. Hence, he seeks anticipatory bail for the petitioner.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) submitted that the petitioner is having no previous cases. However, he opposed for grant of



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anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

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5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the nature of offence, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, subject to certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.1, Karur, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and on further conditions that:

[a] the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhaar card or bank pass book to ensure their identity;

[b] the petitioner is directed to



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deposit a sum of Rs.18,000/- (Rupees Eighteen thousand only) to the credit of the crime number. On such deposit being made, the learned Magistrate shall accept the sureties;

[c] the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required;

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

[e] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

[f] on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner is released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560]; and

[g] if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of BNS.
