PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.482 of
BNSS

PRAYER :- For Anticipatory Bail in Cr.No.96 of
2025 on the file of the respondent police.



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ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

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The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 4(1)(A) and 4(1)(C) of TN Prohibition (Amendment) Act, 2024, in Crime No.96 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the respondent while on surveillance, found that the petitioner was in possession of 47 liquor bottles. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he is no way connected with the alleged occurrence as stated by the prosecution. He further submitted that the petitioner is ready and willing to abide by any conditions that may be imposed by this Court.



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Hence, he seeks anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. side) submitted that the entire property has been recovered and the petitioner is having 57 previous cases. However, he opposed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5. Taking into consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and inspite of there are 57 previous cases pending against the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, with certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date on which the order copy made ready,



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before the learned Judicial Magistrate Court, Thiruvaiyaru, Thanjavur District, on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent police or the police officer who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate Court, Thiruvaiyaru, Thanjavur District, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed and on further condition that:

(a) the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

(b)the petitioner shall make a non refundable deposit of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only) to the credit of the Headmaster, Panchayat Union Middle School, LKB Nagar, Sakkimangalam, Madurai

to his contentions and rights before the
trial Court, for purchasing 30 sets of
Bench Desk for the Tribal students under
"Namakku Naame" Scheme and on such
deposit being made, the learned Judicial
Magistrate Court, Thiruvaiyaru, Thanjavur
District, shall accept the sureties
furnished by the petitioner;

(c) the petitioner shall report
before the respondent police daily at
10.30 a.m., until further orders;

(d) the petitioner shall not tamper
with evidence or witness either during
investigation or trial;

(e) the petitioner shall not abscond
either during investigation or trial;

(f) on breach of any of the aforesaid
conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial



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Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]* and;

(g) if the accused/petitioner thereafter abscond, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of BNS, 2023.
