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dispute. The parties have filed a joint compromise memo dated 23.10.2025.

4. The petitioners and the second respondent are present before this Court in person. They are identified by Ms.S.Santhi, SSI, Melapalayam Police Station, Tirunelveli District. All the parties confirmed the compromise arrived at between them.

5. Though it is alleged that the petitioners had committed the offence under Section 307 of IPC, it is seen from the statement of the doctor that the 2nd respondent had not sustained any external injuries and it is also seen that the 2nd respondent had left the hospital even before the x-ray could be taken.

6. Considering the aforesaid fact, this Court is of the view that the allegation would not attract the offence under Section 307 of IPC. Hence, in view of the compromise and the relationship between the parties, this Court In view of the view that no useful purpose would be served by keeping the impugned final report pending trial. Accordingly,



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the impugned final report is quashed and the Criminal Original Petition stands allowed. The joint compromise memos dated 23.10.2025 shall form part and parcel of the order. The petitioners shall pay a sum of Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only) as costs to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre attached to this Bench and file a photocopy of the receipt along with a memo reporting compliance in the Registry.
