ORDER

3. In view of the submission made by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, this Writ Petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to send a representation to the respondents for conducting the Adal Padal programme.



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The respondents may thereafter consider the representation of the petitioner and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed. There shall be no order as to costs.
