ORDER

(Order of the Court was made by **P.VELMURUGAN, J.**)

The instant writ petition is filed seeking a direction to the respondents to grant emergency leave to the petitioner's father, who is now detained at Central Prison Madurai in relation to the case in C.P.No. 9195 for a period of 6 days

2.The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner's father, Kanagarajan is a convict prisoner and now detained in Central Prison, Madurai in a cheating case in C.P.No.9195. The petitioner's grandmother is struggling for her life and she wishes to see his son, namely the father of the petitioner. Hence, the petitioner made a representation dated 14.10.2025 before the authorities concerned. Since the said representation was not considered, the petitioner has filed the present writ petition.

3.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of the respondents submits that the representation of the petitioner will be considered and necessary orders will be passed.
