ORDER

This writ petition has been filed challenging the rejection order dated 22.09.2025 passed by the fifth respondent and consequently, to direct the third respondent to mutate patta in respect of the lands in S.Nos. 198/1A and 198/1C situated in Malampatti Village, Sivagangai Taluk, Sivagangai District, in favour of the petitioner.

2. When the matter was taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate appearing for respondents 1 to 5 submitted that the petitioner has filed an appeal relating to the present issue, which is
