PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.483 of BNSS

PRAYER :- C-31B.For Bail in Crime No.472/2025 on the  
file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to  
judicial custody on 22.10.2025 for the offences  
punishable under Sections 191(2), 296(b), 115(2) and  
351(3) of BNS, in Crime No.472 of 2025 on the file of  
the respondent police, seeks bail.



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2. The case of the prosecution is that on 21.10.2025, at 12.00 noon, after consuming alcohol outside the TASMAC shop, A1 quarrelled with another person and the same was questioned by the defacto complainant, for that, A1 abused him using filthy language and returned home. Later at 5.30 p.m on the same day, the A1 and other accused persons went to the defacto complainant's house with knives and iron rods and threatened him. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offences as alleged by the prosecution. He would further submit that the petitioner is no way connected with the case, a false case has been lodged as against the petitioner. He would further submit that the petitioner is in custody from 22.10.2025. Hence, he seeks bail.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent would submit that nine



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previous cases are pending against the petitioner and there was no injury in the said occurrence. However, he objected to grant bail to the petitioner.

5. Taking into consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and inspite of nine previous cases pending against the petitioner, and considering the nature of offence, and also considering the period of incarceration suffered by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to the following conditions:

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on executing a separate bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate, Bodi, Theni District, and on further conditions that :-

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

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**[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily twice ie., Morning at 10.30 a.m, and Evening at 05.30 p.m, until further orders;**

[d] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

[e] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

[f] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560];

[g] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 BNS.
