This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. The counsel for the appellant Mr.S.Micheal Heldon Kumar and the counsel for the 1st respondent Mr.S.Raman are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.

AWARD

Aggrieved by the award passed by the Tribunal, the appellant / Transport Corporation has filed the present appeal. The 1st respondent / claimant is the wife of the deceased, and the 2nd respondent herein is the mother of the deceased. Before the Tribunal, despite receipt of notice, the 2nd respondent neither appeared nor represented through a counsel.

2. Today, after due deliberations, the matter has been settled only between the appellants and 1st respondent to a sum of Rs.22,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty Two Lakhs only), as full quit. The appellant is

directed to deposit the said award amount, after deducting the amount already deposited, if any, within a

period of ten weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this award. On such deposit being r
respondent / claimant is permitted to withdraw the amount by filing formal application before the
Tribunal.
