COMMON ORDER

(Order of the Court was made by C.V.Karthikeyan, J.)

These petitions have been filed to condone the delay of 282 days in filing the above appeal in A.S.(MD)SR.Nos.27191 and 27192 of 2025.

2. Earlier we had condoned the delay in representation. In the affidavits filed in support of these petitions, it had been stated that by the time, the petitioner could understand the crux of the issue and to take
