PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.483 of BNSS

PRAYER :- For Bail in C.C.No.741 of 2023 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.VI, Madurai, in Crime No.60 of 2022 on the file of the respondent police.



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ORDER : This Court made the following order :-

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The petitioner / Accused, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 13.10.2025 for the offences punishable under Sections 379, 411 and 34 of IPC, in in C.C.No.741 of 2023 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.VI, Madurai, in Crime No.60 of 2022 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that after the registration of the case in Crime No.60 of 2022 and the respondent police have completed the investigation and filed a charge sheet in C.C.No.741 of 2023 before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.VI, Madurai. He further submitted that due to non-appearance of the petitioner, the trial Court has issued NBW against the petitioner and the same was executed on 13.10.2025. He further submitted that the petitioner undertakes that he will not abscond and he will regularly appear before the Trial Court on hearing dates without fail. He further submitted that the petitioner is in judicial custody from 13.10.2025. Hence, he seeks bail.



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3. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that the petitioner failed to appear before the trial Court, due to which the trial Court had issued Non Bailable Warrant to the petitioner. Hence, he vehemently opposed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

4. Taking into consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the undertaking given by the learned Counsel for the petitioner and also considering the period of incarceration suffered by the petitioner, this court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to the following conditions:

5. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.VI, Madurai District, and on further conditions that :-

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book
