**ORDER**

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed to direct the learned Special Court of SC & ST Principal District and Sessions Judge, Srivilliputhur, to consider the bail application of the petitioner on the same day of his surrender before that Court in connection with Crime No.156 of 2025 on the file of the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent police.

2. Considering the nature of the relief sought for, notice to the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent is dispensed with.

3. The case of the prosecution is that there's an ongoing property dispute involving the petitioner, the *de facto* complainant, and a third party, namely, Sakthi. The petitioner and his mother claim possession and enjoyment of the disputed property, adjacent to the petitioner's land. On 08.10.2025, an altercation occurred between the petitioner and the *de facto* complainant, leading to the petitioner allegedly scolding and assaulting the *de facto* complainant.



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Based on these allegations, an FIR has been registered against the petitioner.

4. Heard the learned counsel on either side and carefully perused the materials available on record.

5. Considering the limited scope of the relief sought for, this Court hereby direct the learned Special Court of SC & ST Principal District and Sessions Judge, Srivilliputhur, to issue prior notice to the *de facto* complainant and thereafter to consider the bail application of the petitioner on the same day of his surrender before that Court in connection with Crime No.156 of 2025 on the file of the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent police.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
