PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.483 of BNSS, 2023.

PRAYER :- For Bail in Cr.No.331 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER: The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/sole Accused, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 07.11.2025 for the offences punishable under Sections 309(4) and 311 of BNS (U/s.392 and 397 IPC) in Crime No.331 of 2025, on the file of the

respondent police, seeks bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that on 07.11.2025 at about 6.30 a.m., when the defacto complainant went to natural call on the backside of Sakkammal Temple wherein the petitioner/accused threatened by showing knife and extorted a sum of Rs.200/- from the pocket of the defacto complainant. Hence, this case.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. However, he has been arrested and he is languishing in jail from 07.11.2025. Therefore, he prays for grant of bail.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent police opposed for grant of bail on the ground that the investigation is still pending. Further, the petitioner has 25 previous cases against him.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances and considering the period of incarceration, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner on certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Virudhunagar, and on further conditions that,

a) the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate/concerned court may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity;

b)the petitioner shall report before the Trial Court daily at 10.30 a.m., and also before the respondent police daily at 05.00 PM until further orders;

c)the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness;

d)the petitioner shall not abscond during trial;

e)On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as

laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

f) If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of BNS.
