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PRAYER : Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents 2 and 3 to cancel the pattas vide Nos. 2675, 2398 of the 4th respondent and the patta No.1864 of the 5th respondent comprising in Survey Nos. 375/1C4A, 375/1C3A2 and 375/1C3A1 respectively, situated at 07 Mangulam Bit-II, Madurai East Taluk, Madurai District and consequently to issue patta in favour of the petitioner by considering his representation sent to the respondents 1 to 3 dated 27.10.2025.

ORDER

This writ petition has been filed seeking issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing respondents 2 and 3 to cancel Patta Nos. 2675 and 2398 standing in the name of the fourth respondent and Patta No.1864 standing in the name of the fifth respondent, in respect of Survey Nos. 375/1C4A, 375/1C3A2 and 375/1C3A1 respectively, situated at 07-Mangulam Bit-II, Madurai East Taluk, Madurai District and consequently to issue patta in favour of the petitioner by considering his representation dated 27.10.2025 submitted to respondents 1 to 3.



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2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate appearing for the official respondents.

3. The petitioner claims that he is the sole legal heir of the subject property and that he is in possession and enjoyment of the same. However, Patta Nos. 2675 and 2398 presently stand in the name of the fourth respondent and Patta No. 1864 stands in the name of the fifth respondent. The grievance of the petitioner is that respondents 4 and 5 are not entitled to the entire extent of the property. In this regard, the petitioner submitted a representation dated 27.10.2025 seeking cancellation of Patta Nos. 2675, 2398 and 1864 and issuance of patta solely in his favour. As no action has been taken on the said representation, the present writ petition has been filed.

4. Learned Government Advocate appearing on behalf of respondents 1 to 3, 6 submits that the petitioner has impleaded the Revenue Divisional Officer as the 6th respondent and that the Revenue Divisional Officer will consider and dispose of the petitioner's representation dated 27.10.2025, in accordance with law.



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5. In view of the above submission, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the matter, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Revenue Divisional Officer/6th respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 27.10.2025 on merits and in accordance with law and pass appropriate orders, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. Such representation shall be considered and disposed of after conducting an inquiry and affording a reasonable opportunity to the petitioner, respondents 4 and 5 and to all other persons who may be affected by such decision during the course of the inquiry. In the event of any issues pertaining to land disputes, the parties shall approach the competent civil court. No costs.
