5. The grievance of the writ petitioner is that his daughters are not cooperating with him for obtaining the legal heir certificate of the deceased petitioner's wife namely Rajalakshmi. The details of the daughters and their respective addresses have been provided by the petitioner in his representation dated 03.10.2025.

6. Considering the above, the writ petition stands disposed of. The 3rd respondent is directed to conduct a field inspection, if he entertains any doubt with reference to the said details and thereafter, proceed to pass orders. The said exercise shall be completed within a period of eight (8) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
