PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.482 of BNSS

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Cr.No.23 of 2022 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER: The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 465, 468, 471 and 420 of IPC, 1860,



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in Crime No.23 of 2022, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the defacto complainant is the legal heir of the Late.Mookan and Senbagamuthu @ Senbagamuthammal. They owned punjai properties comprised in S.Nos.227/4, 228/3, 228/4, 37/3, 37/5, 37/8 situated at Kalappaipatti Village, Kayatharu Taluk, Thoothukudi District. After their demise, the properties were inherited to the defacto complainant and others. While so, the petitioner herein entered into a criminal conspiracy with the Sub-Registrar, Surandai. Despite holding no right or title, the petitioner allegedly fabricated a forged Sale Deed dated 04.05.2018, and registered the same in favour of NVR Energy Private Limited, with the specific intent of illegally grabbing the defacto complainant's ancestral property. Hence, a case has been registered as against the petitioner.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and the petitioner has not committed any offence. He seeks this Court to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.



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4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl. side) appearing for the respondent submitted that the offences committed by the petitioner are serious in nature. Further, the Accused Nos.1 to 8 were already granted anticipatory bail.

5.Considering the fact that the petitioner is a purchaser, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

6.Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the Learned Judicial Magistrate No. II, Kovilpatti, within a period of fifteen days from the date on which the order copy made ready and on further conditions that:

[a]the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhaar card or bank pass book to ensure their identity.

[b]the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., for a period of one week and thereafter, as and when required.

[c]the petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either



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during investigation or trial.

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[e]On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner is released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[f]If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of BNS.
