PRAYER :- Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents 1 and 2 herein to consider and pass appropriate orders on the petitioners representation dated 24.10.2025 sent for the purpose of to take necessary action on the basis of the G.O. (D) No.346, Labour and Employment (P2) Department, dated 10.03.2005, issued by the 1st respondent herein to recover the service monetary benefit amount of the petitioner of a sum of Rs.6,47,072/- with interest due and payable from



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the 3rd respondent herein by invoking the provisions of Revenue Recovery Act.

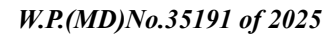

ORDER
