2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned counsel for the first respondent.

3. This Court, by order, dated 25.02.2025, has granted conditional stay. As per the order of this Court, dated 25.02.2025, the Insurance Company has deposited the 75% of the award amount along with proportionate accrued interest and costs to the credit of M.C.O.P.No.29 of 2021, on the file of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Srivilliputhur.

Considering the above facts and circumstances of the case, this Civil Miscellaneous Petition is allowed and the petitioners are permitted to withdraw 50% of the deposited amount along with proportionate accrued interest and costs, deposited by the first respondent/appellant to the credit of M.C.O.P.No.29 of 2021, on the file of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Srivilliputhur, as per the order of the Tribunal by filing proper application.
