PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.483 of BNSS

PRAYER :- For Bail in Crime No.141 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police.



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ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 10.09.2025 for the offences punishable under Sections 331(4) and 305(a) of BNS Act, in Crime No.141 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the accused persons trespassed into the house, broke open the steel beru, and took away 4½ sovereigns. Hence, the complaint."

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offences as alleged by the prosecution. He further submitted that the petitioner is in judicial custody from 10.09.2025. Hence, he seeks bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that 14 previous cases are pending against the petitioner. He further stated that



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2½ sovereigns have been recovered. However, he opposed the grant of bail to the petitioner.

5. Taking into consideration of the fact that the charge sheet has been filed and also considering the period of incarceration suffered by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to the following conditions:

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Manapparai, and on further conditions that :-

[a] the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhaar card or bank pass book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioner shall report before the trial Court daily at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.

[c] the petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence
