PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.482 of BNSS

PRAYER :-

C-24AB. For Anticipatory Bail in Crime no.5 of 2025 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 406, 408, 468, 471, 477(A), 420 r/w 34 of IPC, in Crime No.5 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the defacto complainant is the Deputy Registrar, Trichy, and he lodged a complaint that there is a malpractice and falsification of account in 5 items at the Thottiyam Branch of Tiruchirappalli District Central Co-operative Bank to the tune of Rs.66,00,000/- (Rupees Sixty Six lakhs only). Hence, the case.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the co-accused misappropriated the amount to the tune of Rs.66 lakhs. Based on 81 enquiry, the petitioner was arrayed as an accused. He further submitted that the petitioner is working as a Branch Manager, Thottiyam Branch, Trichy District Central Co-operative Bank, and he has not committed any offences as alleged by the prosecution. He

further submitted that the petitioner's property was already attached in the said misappropriation case and the petitioner is ready and willing to abide by any conditions which may be imposed by this Court. Hence, he seeks anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that the investigation is pending. Hence, he opposed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, subject to certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial

Magistrate, Thottiyam, within a period of fifteen days from the date on which the order copy is made ready and on further conditions that:

[a]the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhaar card or bank pass book to ensure their identity;

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 05.30 p.m, for a period of one week and thereafter as and when required;

[c]the petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

[d]the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

[e]On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate

action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner is released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560];

[f]If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of BNS.
