**PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.483 of BNSS**

**PRAYER :-** For Bail in Crime No.326 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police.



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**ORDER :** The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 15.11.2025 for the offences punishable under Sections 281, 125(a), 303(2) of BNS and Section 21(1) of Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation Act), 2023, in Crime No.326 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that on 15.11.2025 at about 8.00 p.m., when the victim was proceeding near the Karur–Trichy Main Road, the accused drove his Bharat Benz bearing Registration No. TN 41 AY 0358 in a rash and negligent manner and dashed against the victim. Further, after enquiry, it was found that the accused had loaded Cauvery river sand in the said vehicle without valid permission. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offences as alleged by the prosecution. He further submitted that the petitioner is in judicial custody from 15.11.2025. Hence, he seeks bail to the

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petitioner.

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4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that two previous cases are pending against the petitioner. Therefore, he opposed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

5. Considering the nature of offence and also considering the period of incarceration suffered by the petitioners , this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to the following conditions:

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate, Krishnarayapuram, and on further conditions that :-

[a] the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhaar card or bank pass book to ensure their identity.



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[b] the petitioner shall make a non refundable deposit of Rs.3,000/- (Rupees Three Thousand only) to the credit of The Head Master, Government Higher Secondary School, Odaipatty, Theni District, in SBI Account No. 11268003539, IFSC No.SBIN0000764, State Bank of India, South Car Street, Uthamapalayam, Theni District. This fund shall be utilized for the purpose of purchasing furniture (Benches & Desks) for newly constructed class rooms under "Namakku Name" Scheme, without prejudice to his contentions and rights before the trial Court, and on such deposit being made, the learned Judicial Magistrate shall accept the sureties furnished by the petitioner;

[c] the petitioner shall report before the trial Court daily at 10.30 a.m., and before the respondent police daily at 5.30 p.m.,at until further orders.

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[e] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[f] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the



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learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner is released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[g] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 BNS.
