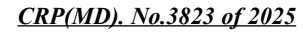

PRAYER :- Civil Revision Petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, to set aside the fair and decreetal order dated 28.03.2024 passed in C.M.A. No. 4 of 2022 on the file of the Sub-Court, Theni and declare the petitioner also as the legal heir of the deceased Balamurugan.

3. Today, the third respondent has filed an affidavit, since an amicable settlement has been arrived at between them. The learned Judge for the third respondent submits that since both the parties have resolved their issues amicably and entered into a compromise, the Plaintiff is also to be declared as a legal heir of deceased Balamurugan along with the respondents 4 and 5.

4. The learned counsel for the respondents 4 and 5 has also not raised any objections in declaring the revision petitioner as one of the legal heirs of the deceased Balamurugan.

Recording the same, the order passed by the Sub Court, Theni dated 28.03.2024 in C.M.A.No.4 of 2022 is set aside in respect of this petitioner alone and accordingly, this Civil Revision Petition is allowed in terms of the affidavit filed by the third respondent and the compromise memo filed before the Appellate Court dated 03.03.2023, which shall form part of this order. No costs.
