Respondent Police.



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ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 189(2), 296(b), 115(2), 118(1) and 351(2) of BNS, 2023 (corresponding offences under Sections 142, 294(b), 323, 324 and 506(i) IPC) in Crime No.305 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that due to property the petitioners herein are said to have attacked the defacto complainant and also abused him in filthy language. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. side) submits that the injured has been discharged from the hospital and the investigation of the case is pending. He would further submit that A1, A2 and A4 are having one, two and two previous respectively and the other petitioners are not having any previous case.

4. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the



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learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondent police.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also the fact that it is a case of eviction of defacto complainant, who is the sister of A1 and that there is no civil suit filed by any of the parties and that the injured has already been discharged from the hospital, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners, subject to certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance, on condition that the petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Radhapuram within a period of fifteen days from the date on which the order copy is made ready and on further conditions that:

[a] the petitioners and the sureties shall affix their



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photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhaar card or bank pass book to ensure their identity;

[b] The petitioners 1 to 4 shall appear before the respondent, Police daily at 10.00 am for a period of two weeks and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners 5 and 6 shall appear before the respondent / Police as and when required for interrogation;

[c] the petitioners shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take



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appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners are released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[f]If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of BNS.
