PRAYER :-

To enlarge the petitioner / Accused on bail in connection with the case
in C.C.No.596 of 2022 pending on the file of the learned District and

Sessions Court for Communal Clash Cases, Madurai, Madurai District in Cr.No.43 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed to enlarge the petitioner / Accused on bail in connection with the case in C.C.No.596 of 2022 pending on the file of the learned District and Sessions Court for Communal Clash Cases, Madurai, Madurai District in Cr.No.43 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner was found in illegal possession of 2.750 kgs of Ganja. Based on the confession of A2, the petitioner was implicated in this case. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offences as alleged by the prosecution. He further submitted that based on the confession of co-accused, the petitioner was falsely implicated in this case. He further submitted that the petitioner is ready and willing to

abide by any conditions which may be imposed by this Court and he is in judicial custody from 05.08.2025. Hence, he seeks bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that there are two previous cases pending as against the petitioner and the property has been recovered. However, he opposed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

5. Taking into consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and also the fact that the quantity of the contraband is not commercial and the property has been recovered and also considering the period of incarceration suffered by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to the following conditions:

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned District and Sessions Court for Communal Clash Cases, Madurai, Madurai District, and on further conditions that :-

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioner shall report before the Dean of Theni Government Hospital daily at 10.30 a.m., and shall do social service at the said hospital till 4.00 p.m., for a period of one week. Thereafter, the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily evening at 6.00 p.m., until further orders.

[c] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].
